## The Math Lab at Wellesley High School

The math lab is a drop in resource for students who have questions about the math curriculum they are studying. No advance appointment necessary. Students are invited to attend when they have a directed research or free block and have questions about homework, assessments or would like a space to study and review their math material.

Students coming to the lab are expected to,

- come prepared with their work and specific questions.
- bring their assessments with them if they are required to review these with the lab teacher.
- be prepared to be an active participant.
- implement the teacher feedback.

While there may be times when a student will be able to work one-on-one with a math lab teacher for a length of time, this is not the norm. The lab is located in room 452 during block 1 and in room 427 during all other blocks when a teacher is assigned to the lab. Students may drop in during any block that is staffed by a math teacher. Students may decide to spend part or all of the block in Math Lab. Please refer to the schedule below. NOTE: Block 4 Math Lab is available for students during lunch 1 \& lunch 3.
