- 20\% - SBG Free Response Questions by Chapter

This year one of the grading categories will be determined by standards based grading (SBG). SBG tracks a student's performance on a learning outcome throughout the course. For AP Statistics, SBG will be used to assess Free Response Questions. Each question will receive a score of a 4-1 which aligns with an AP Exam scoring rubric. Students can demonstrate a

4: Exceeds Expectations
3: Meets Expectations
2: Approaching Expectations
1: Does Not Meet Expectations
Each FRQ grade will be published to PowerSchool so students, parents/guardians and guidance can see the student's progress. Individual FRQ grades will not be counted into the final grade. Your teacher will enter a grade under the category Free Response Questions that corresponds to your mastery of the learning outcome. This grade will be updated at mid semester and the end of the semester. The percentage will be entered as follows:
