Classroom Policies and Expectations

Be prepared and productive:

Students are expected to arrive to class each day prepared to participate.

Grading Policy

Assessments

- During each term there will be roughly 3 assessments
- These will be either a test or a project relating to what we are learning at the moment
- Each assessment will be worth 15% of your term grade

Quizzes and Collected Classwork

- As we work through our units I will collect classwork for a grade or we will have a short quiz relating to the topic we have covered
- These quizzes and classworks will be relate closely to questions done on Delta Math

Cumulative Assessment

- At the end of each term there will be a cumulative assessment that covers everything we have learned in the quarter

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- This will be worth 30% of your term grade (the equivalent of two test grades)
- There will not be a final exam for this course but there will be a cumulative at the end of term 4

Flex Grade

- At the end of each term I will enter a flex grade. This will be either the grade you received on your cumulative assessment or the average of your term assessments, whichever is higher

Homework

- I will assign homework on Delta Math, however these assignments will not be graded
- It is in your best interest to do the assignments so that you can ask questions and see how you are doing with the unit
- When we have a quiz or collected classwork assignment they will often relate to the questions that were on Delta Math for homework you it is good to make sure you understand the types of questions that were assigned
